

Scandinavian Simplicity Correction of Errors TWIN size only

Sometimes mistakes slip in despite our best efforts to have everything error free - my sincerest apologies.

CUTTING AND SUB-CUTTING THE STRIPS

For Twin size only, the F1 fabric strip is accidentally stating you need to cut (9) 1 ½" F1 strips. It should have said you need to cut (9) 2" F1 strips.

The yardage was sadly calculated based on 1 ½" strips, so this causes you to need to have 3 ⅞ yards of F1 (instead of 3 ¾ yards).

BLOCK A - UNFINISHED SIZE 4 ½" (B), 6 ½" (L), OR 9 ½" (T) SQUARE

1 Using 1" (B), 1 ¼" (L), or **2" (T) F1 strips** (cut one of the 1 ½" (T) F1 strips into two 1 ½" × 21" strips first), sew them with F3, F4, and F5 strips in the order shown below. Sew every other seam in the opposite direction to prevent "bowing". Press away from F1. Repeat for a total of 2 (B), 3 (L), or 4 ½ (T) strip sets.

Due to the above error, Step 1 is now reading ...2" (T) F1 strips... (and not 1 ½" (T) F1 strips...).
